
STEP 7


Remove the red cord retainers, unwind the cord and dispose of the cord retainers.



STEP 8

Pull cord to bottom of side channel and secure cord stop in the locking mechanism.

Trim excess cord to 1.5cm once the blind is working correctly.




TROUBLE SHOOTING

The blind is supplied pre-tensioned however, should this need adjusted, please adjust as follows:

- 1. Use the 2mm allen key supplied to adjust the cord stops (see fig 8A).
- 2. If the blind does not stay in position or raises on its own accord, Add tension to the cords and adjust to the marking on the cord stop
- **3.** If the blind is difficult to open or close, adjust the position on cord stop to the lower marking

NB – ensure the bottom bar is level.

4. If the bottom bar is not level adjust the cord stop tension. To do this, remove it from locking mechanism and adjust accordingly.





BLIND CONTENTS



1 Headbox

2 Left side channel

3 Right side channel

4 x countersunk screws

5 2 x pan head screws (optional)

TOOLS REQUIRED


Screw driver

2mm Allen Key (included)




STEP 1

Peel the backing from the red double sided tape on the headbox.




STEP 2

Secure headbox to top of window using double sided tape.



STEP 3


Secure headbox to window frame at each side using countersunk screws.




STEP 4

Slide the right side channel at a 30° angle onto the bottom bar end cap to ensure position under the headbox lip.

Push the lower end of the side guide into position against the edge of the window.




Final position



STEP 5

Secure the side guides into position using the countersunk screws provided.



REPEAT STEPS 4 + 5 FOR LEFT SIDE CHANNEL.

STEP 6

For larger windows (04 or bigger) additional fixing pan head screws are supplied.
